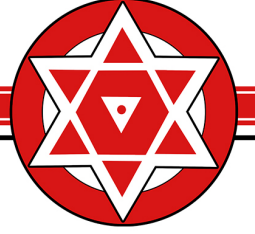

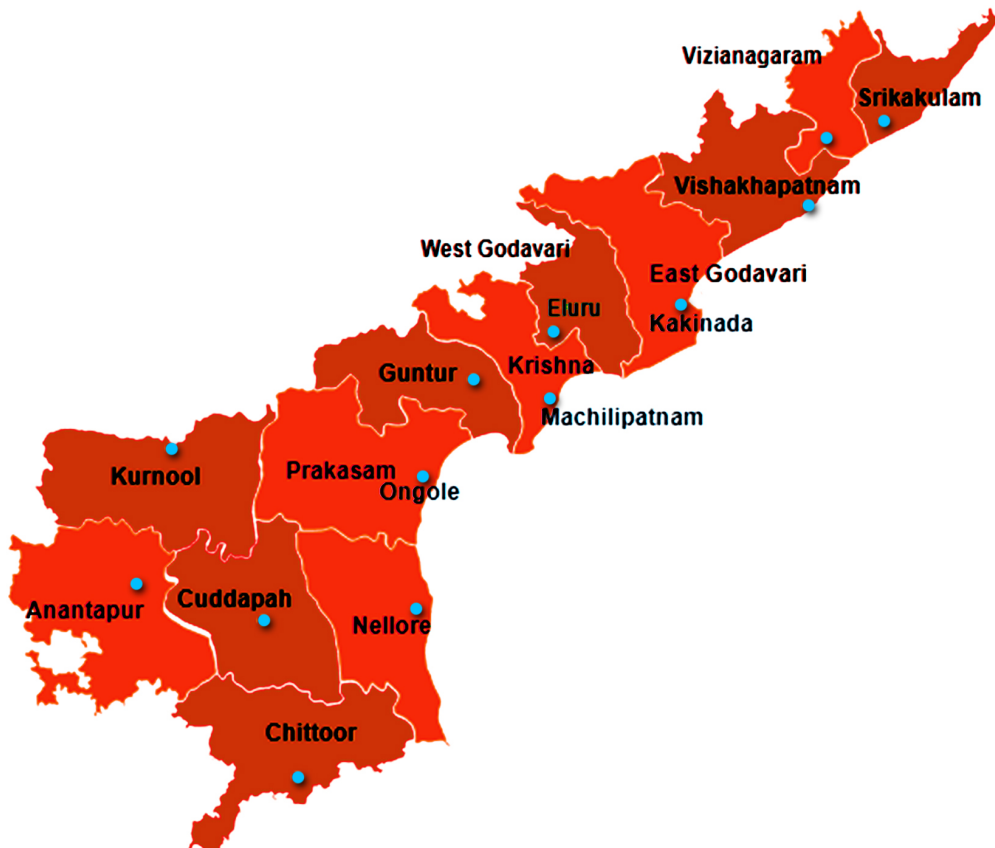

AGRICULTURE

1. **Rythu Saayam:** All farmers will get Rs. 8000 per acre per annum for cultivation purposes.
2. **Rythu Rakshana Bharosa:** All small/marginal farmers/tenants aged 60 and above and fishermen and weavers aged 58 and above will be given Rs. 5000 per month to enable them to lead a decent life.
3. **Rythu Raju:** Promote Opportunity zones for farmers in all districts with export linkages for their produce and create prosperity through shareholding and profit sharing for the farmers.
4. World-Class Grain & Fruit Global Market will be set up at a suitable location in the Godavari basin at a budget allocation of Rs. 5000





Crores with State of Art Technologies for the welfare and prosperity of the farming community.

5. **Agricultural Infrastructure:** Crop-wise warehouses, agro-related food processing facilities and cold storages will be set up at Mandal level along with establishment of a robust cold chain network supported by logistics networks with private sector collaboration and special bodies.
6. Special agricultural zones will be created in Government lands, wherein, the youth interested in promoting agriculture/animal husbandry will be given parcels of land on 30 years lease to enhance production by adopting new technologies.

Sowbhagya Rayalaseema:

The Rayalaseema region will be notified as drought-affected area for a period of ten years. All the facilities, concessions, subsidies for the notified drought areas will be made applicable. Highest priority will be given for providing water for agriculture and drinking water on a war-footing. The sharing of waters from various rivers to Rayalaseema region, by resolving issues that are pending in various courts and tribunals will be achieved within 2 years. Public sector and private sector industrial units will be set-up to explore the mineral resources of Rayalaseema in order to bring prosperity, peace, and employment opportunities to the youth.



8. Heavy Thrust will be given for Modern Agricultural practices such as Micro/drip/sprinkler irrigation/precision farming/rain water harvesting/tanks and ponds etc.

9.

Special Development plan for North Andhra:

Interlinking of Rivers/Construction of new reservoirs/ Fishing Jetties / Harbours /Tourism clusters/ Modern agriculture systems etc. will be undertaken with financial support from Multinational Aid Agencies and companies in collaboration with State Government to develop Srikakulam, Vijayanagaram, Araku Valley and Vishakapatnam areas.

10.

Konaseema Development:



- A. World-class irrigation network, roads, bypasses, underpasses, culverts, bridges, fly-overs, coconut based auxiliary industries and other infrastructure will be created with financial support from international bodies like World Bank, IMF, JICA etc., to bring progress and wealth to Konaseema.
- B. New Coastal Railway line will be built with State and Central collaboration connecting Kakinada and Tenali via Amalapuram, Narsapuram and Machilipatnam to promote easier and quicker



transportation of agricultural products.

C. Rajahmundry will be upgraded to an International Airport.

11.

Rythu Sampada Scheme:



- A. High-quality inputs such as micronutrients, fertilizers, biocides, agro-tools & machinery will be given free of cost to small and marginal farmers.
- B. Modern ways of irrigation will be promoted for cultivation on un-irrigated /fallow lands.
- C. Low-interest credit will be provided to farmers.

12.

SRI (System of Rice Intensification):



will be adopted to enhance yields by 3 times with supply of High Grade inputs/agro machinery/implements/ fertilizers etc., free of cost initially for the first 3 years.

- 13. Agriculture will be brought under the frame work of MNREGA benefiting all agricultural communities.



14. **Flexible Profitable Price System (PPS)** for 25 additional crops will be introduced in addition to the crops already covered under Minimum Support Price mechanism.
15. Free solar pump-sets to all farmers.
16. Agro Awareness campaigns will be organized at the field level for every season to educate and inform the farmer about available organizational support, techniques, and technology (Shed net, Green House, Laser Land Levelling, Drip Irrigation etc.) by using latest ICT methods.

17.

Rythu Supermarkets:

Farmers can bring their produce, semi-finished or finished agricultural products to this supermarket which will be set-up as a joint-venture by Government and farmers. All the employees/workers in the Super Markets will be from the families of farmers.





EDUCATION



18. Free education up to PG level.
19. Free bus and railway passes for all students and free canteens for college students.
20. Distribution of free laptops to all students at junior college level.
21. One Government Arts/Science College/Polytechnic/ITI/ Agricultural college in each assembly constituency and one Veterinary College and Hospital in every district will be set-up in a phased manner.
22. Innovation hubs/incubation centres at all graduate colleges.
23. Anganwadis will be converted into Nursery (Nurture) Schools.
24. Universal (common) hostels for all communities under one roof.
25. One fee per year for all competitive exams in the State.
26. Compulsory free skill development and vocational programs for all students at every college to make them highly employable.
27. Fine Arts & Culture Schools and Colleges will be set up in all districts to promote culture and traditions of Andhra Pradesh.
28. State of the Art Sports Complexes at every district for every sport with experienced coaches, mentors and physical trainers and hostels with good infrastructure will be created.
29. Low interest loans will be provided to the poor students for studying abroad.



HEALTH



30. Universal Free Health Insurance scheme at Rs. 10 lakhs per person. For Craftsmen/Artisans, additional insurance of Rs. 2 lakhs for infirmities/deformities caused while undertaking their respective professions/trades will be provided.
31. Upgradation of all District hospitals into Super Specialty Hospitals and in three years' time.
32. Mobile diagnostic clinics for every Mandal.
33. Mobile pharmacies in all Mandals to serve the people.
34. All Primary Health Centres will be upgraded to 30 bedded hospitals with 24/7 services in a phased manner.
35. Ambulances will be made available 24/7 for clusters of five Tribal villages for medical emergencies. Tele-medicine facilities and Health Cubes will be installed in the remotest locations for diagnosing a range of illnesses.
36. Residential Accommodation Clusters for doctors in rural/semi-urban areas with all facilities.
37. Special Geriatric wards and medicines will be made available for the elderly.
38. Elderly Homes with all facilities will be set-up at every mandal with all facilities.



39. Development of Local Government Institutions:

- A. Elections to Local Government Institutions will be conducted immediately, timely elections will be conducted in future and strictly we will follow the 73rd and 74th Amendments of Indian Constitution.
- B. **Urban Development:** 130 towns will be transformed into Smart Cities. 10 towns in each district will be developed as Smart Cities in the next 5 years through higher outlays. These smart cities will incorporate information and communication technologies (ICT) to improve the performance and quality of public services such as energy, transportation and safe drinking water, sewerage and drainage systems in order to reduce resource consumption, wastage and overall costs. The aim of smart cities is to enhance the quality of living for its citizens through adoption of smart technology.
- C. Housing to all through construction of multi-storeyed buildings in rural and urban areas.
- D. **Rural Development:** Abdul Kalam's vision of PURA (provision of urban amenities in rural areas) for rural development and generation of employment opportunities with an aim to create prosperous villages will be implemented.



EMPLOYMENT AND INDUSTRY PROMOTION



40. Regular Employment Notifications from Public Service Commission by following the Job calendar will be ensured.
41. All backlog vacancies will be filled up within six months.
42. Industry-specific economic zones with world class technology will be set up with foreign investment.
43. 25000 new MSMEs will be promoted in the next 5 years by providing infrastructure and seed capital with an aim to generate 2 million jobs in the next 5 years. A Venture Capital Fund with an outlay of Rs. 10000 crores will be created to encourage new entrepreneurs and the start-up ecosystem in the State. A Hub and Spoke Model will be used to promote local innovation, local talent and local industry.
44. 20% of the Venture Capital Fund (Rs. 2000 Crores) will be set apart for promotion of Start-ups/MSME units promoted by SC/ST entrepreneurs.
45. Private Sector will be encouraged to actively participate in the growth-led policies of the State Government for development of roads, rail, waterways tourism, and airports, harbours, ports and other infrastructure by providing substantial incentives and guarantees by the State Government.
46. Promotion of renewable energy (solar/biomass/wind).
47. State of the Art new buses will be introduced to promote safe travel at reasonable cost. APSRTC will be thoroughly revamped with additional buses and bus stations.



WOMEN EMPOWERMENT AND SAFETY



48. 33% political reservation for women in the Andhra Pradesh Assembly.

49. Women welfare:

- A. Provision of interest free loan up to Rs. 50000 for girls' marriage along with a grant of Rs. 50000 for girls with Tenth-class passed certificates.
 - B. Mandal-wise centres for women safety and empowerment.
 - C. Gender Advisors in every Mandal Headquarters.
 - D. Marriage/function halls in every Mandal.
 - E. Two sarees under Aadapaduchu Kanuka in a year.
 - F. Crèches/Child and Mother Rooms at all government institutions, bus and railway stations etc.
- 50.** Exclusive Specialty Hospitals for women-wellness in every district.
- 51.** Mahila Banks will be set-up for every district.



**52. Law and Order and Crime Control:**

- A. Police Reforms will be undertaken.
- B. Police canteens will be set up.
- C. All police personnel will be provided with accommodation.
- D. Self-financing housing scheme for police personnel will be implemented.
- E. Public-friendly Police systems will be brought in. Complaints will be registered electronically and FIR will be registered as soon as possible.
- F. All vacancies in police department will be filled up in one year time.
- G. 25000 new posts of Special police commandos will be created for Traffic/night beats etc. on consolidated basis and will be regularised depending upon their performance.

IRRIGATION AND DRINKING WATER

- 53.** Higher budget outlays will be provided for irrigation projects, revival and renovation of water bodies, and construction of check dams. Meaningful dialogue with the State of Odisha to be pursued to increase rightful share of water to Andhra Pradesh for all the Inter State Rivers.





54. Propagation of modern irrigation systems and rain water harvesting measures for every village. Promotion of high value and low water intensive crops with substantial support from Government
55. Interlinking of Rivers by Smart Waterways Grid by harnessing flood waters and diverting them to drought areas, and building drinking water reservoirs.
56. Safe drinking water facility to every hamlet in the State in two years' time.

FISHERIES DEVELOPMENT



57. Separate Ministry of Fisheries will be created for fishermen welfare and fisheries development.
58. Fisheries Development Bank will be set-up to finance welfare and development schemes for fishermen, setting up fish landing centres, processing centres, fishing jetties / harbours. Value addition to fisheries will be created through technology transfer, MOU's with foreign countries (Ice Land) and deployment of smart technologies.



59. Financial support of Rs. 500 per day will be given to marine fishermen during natural calamities/cyclones when they are advised “not to go to sea”.
60. Safe drinking water facilities for all fishing villages within two years.
61. Assured livelihood for 300 days in a year.
62. Free Life and Health insurance for all fishermen.
63. Financial Support will be provided for Deep Sea Fishing Ships and Infrastructure.
64. Multi storeyed housing for all fishermen.

ANIMAL HUSBANDRY



65. Thrust on profitable Aqua/Dairy/poultry/fisheries production with liberal venture capital funding will be provided. All native breeds of cattle like Punganur and Ongole will be protected.



MINORITIES WELFARE:



66. Minorities Welfare:

- A. Implementation of Sachar Committee recommendations
- B. Free vocational training, building of community halls and burial grounds for all minority communities.
- C. Establishment of Government Unani Medical College at Kadapa.
- D. Protection of Wakf Properties.

67. Relli Community Welfare and Development:

- A. Multi-storeyed apartments to accommodate every Relli Family.
- B. Special Priority (roster) in employment in Government Jobs.
- C. One time financial aid of Rs.50, 000 to Relli Youth to start business.
- D. Auto-Rickshaws at 50 % subsidy.
- E. Free-Scooters to Relli women employed in Private Sector.

68. Artisans and Craftsmen Welfare and Development:

- A. 200 units of free electricity for all Artisan businesses
- B. Special health facilities will be provided to artisans involved in hazardous and unsafe professions such as black smithy etc.



- C. Craftsmen Creative Zones will be set-up for production/ demonstration and marketing of speciality handi-crafts such as Narsapur lace, hand-woven sarees of Venkatagiri / Dharmavaram / Yemmiganur / Madanapalli, Etikoppaka Lacquer ware products, Kalamkari, bronze casting, Dokra Castings, Budithi artefacts, Bidriware, Banjara needle craft, Pembarthi sheet metal products, Puppets, Toys and Dolls of Kondapalli etc. and Stone carvings of AallaGadda etc.
- D. Fashion Design centres will be created in 12 areas where the handloom is concentrated.
- E. Custom made products for export will be encouraged.
- F. Financial support for marketing of the products will be provided.
- G. The Honour and dignity of the artisans will be ensured with Awards/Honours by the State as the Japanese do.
- H. Special Showrooms/exhibitions will be built for the products made by Tribal Artisans.
- I. Special Handlooms and Textiles Nodes will be created as an integrated facility with housing, product centres, research/design/ development centres and marketing houses on 10 acres to 100 acres sites, to promote weaving and handloom industry with special provisions and world-class infrastructure.



69. Subsidized inputs and motors will be provided and special houses with larger floor-space will be built for weavers to accommodate their looms with solar power.
70. Welfare of the professional communities such as Rajakas, Goldsmiths, Blacksmiths, Barbers etc. will be given high priority by providing them with finance, infrastructure, training and special reservations to undertake their respective professions with dignity.

SPECIAL WELFARE SCHEMES



71. Cash deposit of Rs.2500 to Rs.3500 per month into bank accounts of the women depending on the family-size instead of ration rice, palmoline, dhal etc.
72. Supply of free gas cylinders (6 to 10 per year) depending upon the family size.
73. **Gold Loan Scheme** – Loans will be provided against mortgage of gold jewellery at a low interest rate of artha rupaay. If repaid within 1 year, the interest will be reduced to pavala vaddee.
74. **Recurring Loans will be given to petty traders** (fruit/vegetable/fish/food vendors etc.) at pavala vaddee up to Rs. 10000 without any security.



75. Free gas stove for newly married couples.
76. Contributory Pension Scheme for Government Employees will be abolished. Equal work and equal pay will be implemented.
77. Welfare of Differently-Abled Persons:
 - A. A holistic plan for the welfare of differently-abled persons will be prepared and implemented for each district bringing them into mainstream of society.
 - B. Family pension of Rs.5000 per month for partially differently-abled and Rs. 10000 per month for fully differently-abled persons
 - C. Up gradation and setting up of special-schools.
 - D. Fill-up all the backlog vacancies as per the provisions of the Act.
 - E. Technology-driven interventions will be undertaken for the wellness and wellbeing of Differently Abled persons.
 - F. Custom-made petrol scooters will be given free of cost to Differently Abled persons depending on their needs.
 - G. State-of-Art Aids and Applications will be provided free of cost (if necessary, such aids/appliances will be imported and given)
 - H. Special arrangements for their education, health, mobility and employability will be made.
 - I. Special houses and special care centres will be set-up.
76. Corporation of betterment of economically backward Upper Castes and hostels for economically backward students.
77. Increase of Reservations by additional 5 per cent to BCs will be carried out and political reservations for BCs.



80. Top Priority for Peaceful solution for SC sub division issue and implementation of SC & ST Sub plan.
81. Steps will be taken to bring reservations for Kapus under the 9th schedule of the Constitution.
82. 2013 Land Acquisition Act will strictly be implemented and Resettlement and rehabilitation measures will be given high priority.
83. Land owners will be made shareholders for the lands acquired for commercial projects in addition to the compensation paid for such acquisition.
84. Tribal people affected due to the Polavaram project will be compensated in full measure.
85. Tribal people will be given an equal share in all the state forest produce.
86. Serious Legal Action will be taken against corrupt persons in Public Life. Lokayukta Act will be strictly implemented. Even there is no exemption for chief minister.
87. Higher Pension for sports personalities will be given.
88. Provision of pensions, bus passes and housing facilities for the welfare of Journalists (media persons).
89. Relevant Forest Acts will be strictly implemented for the benefit of Tribal people.
90. Housing for rural and urban people through construction of multi-storeyed buildings.



91. Cultural tourism, Natural Health tourism, Religious tourism, Eco-tourism, Coastal tourism will be given a big boost with an aim to create one lakh jobs.
92. Four government colleges will be started to offer degree/diploma courses in the Tourism sector immediately.
93. Mangrove forests will be planted along coastal areas/ sensitive river banks. Protection of Ecology and Environment will be given highest priority. Plantation of 50 lakh saplings every year. Students involved in planting and protection of trees will be rewarded.
94. A Separate Act will be enacted creating a Constituency Development Authority (CDA) for each Assembly constituency for development of that constituency with an Integrated Plan of Action by empowering it as an administrative unit. All the Schemes of the State and Central governments and local bodies will be converged and implemented by this Authority. The Development works such as roads, irrigation, water supply and sanitation, power supply, sewerage, solid waste management, drainage, slum area development, up gradation and setting up of new schools/colleges, bus facilities, traffic issues and pollution problems will be developed. SC/ST/BC and Women welfare, housing, promotion of Local Trade and agricultural issues etc. will be handled by the Developmental Authority in a time-bound manner. All pending, suspended and abandoned (by contractors) works will be taken-up on war footing and completed.



95. A Special plan along with the assurances given in the Manifesto with Sector-wise Blueprint for each Assembly Constituency will be prepared and implemented considering the requirements and developmental needs of each Constituency.
96. We fulfil all the assurances given by the Jana Sena Party during the Praja Porata Yathra along with the assurances given in this Manifesto.
